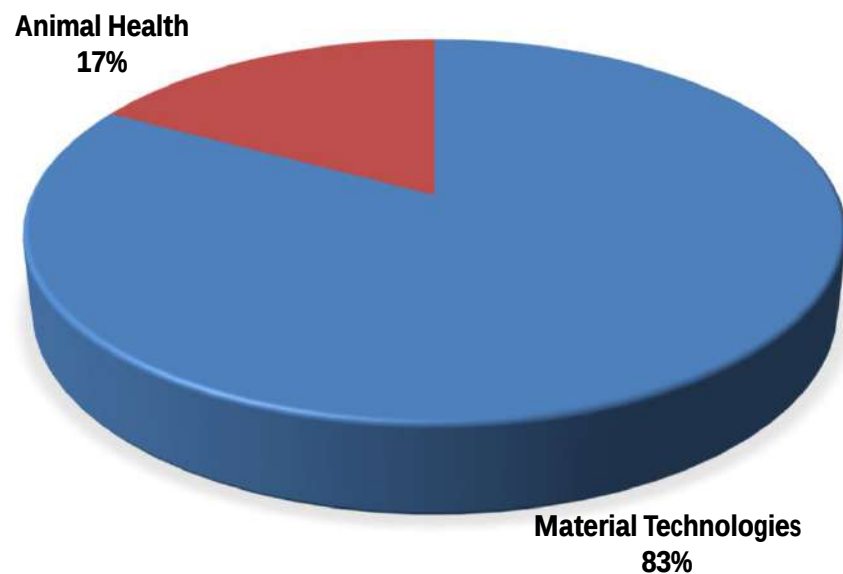

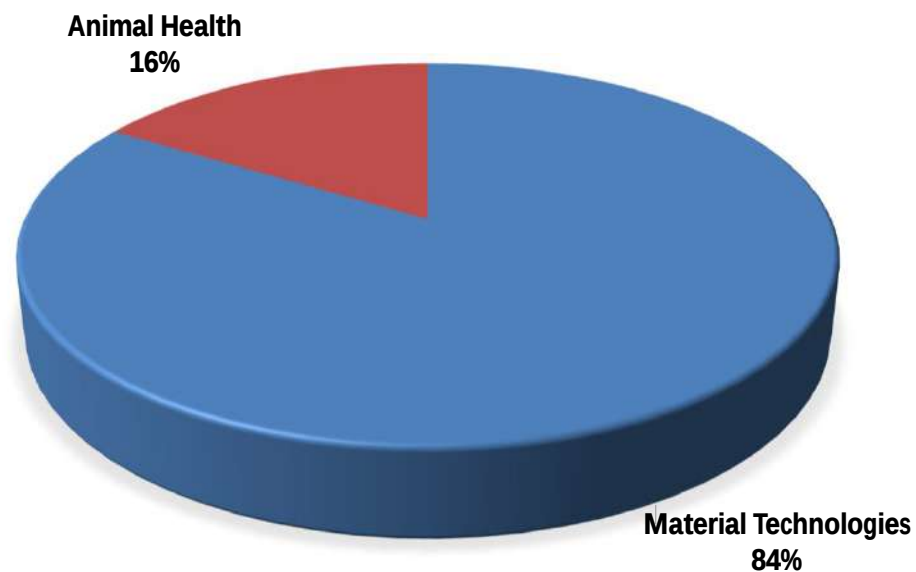

Share of Revenue by Segment

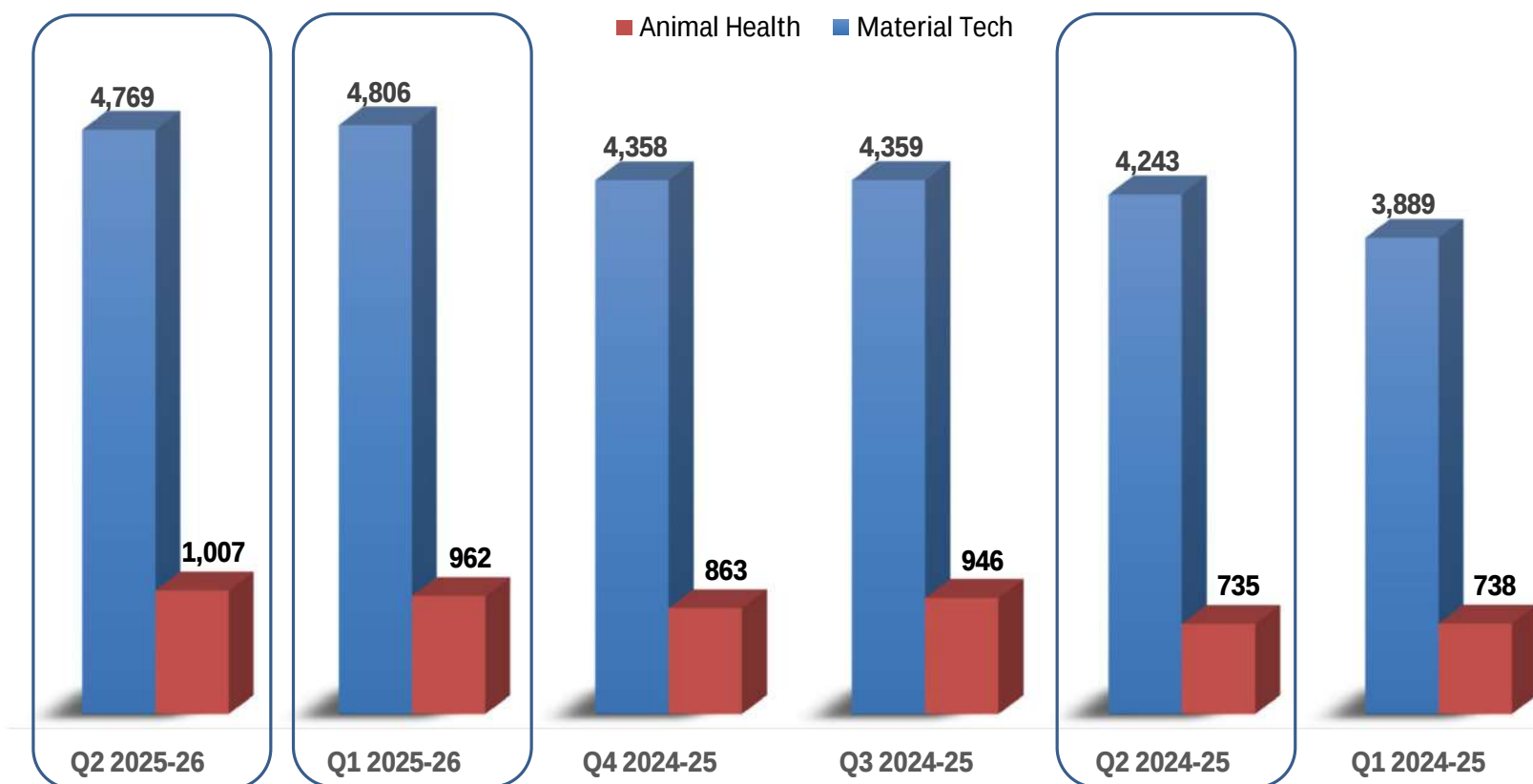

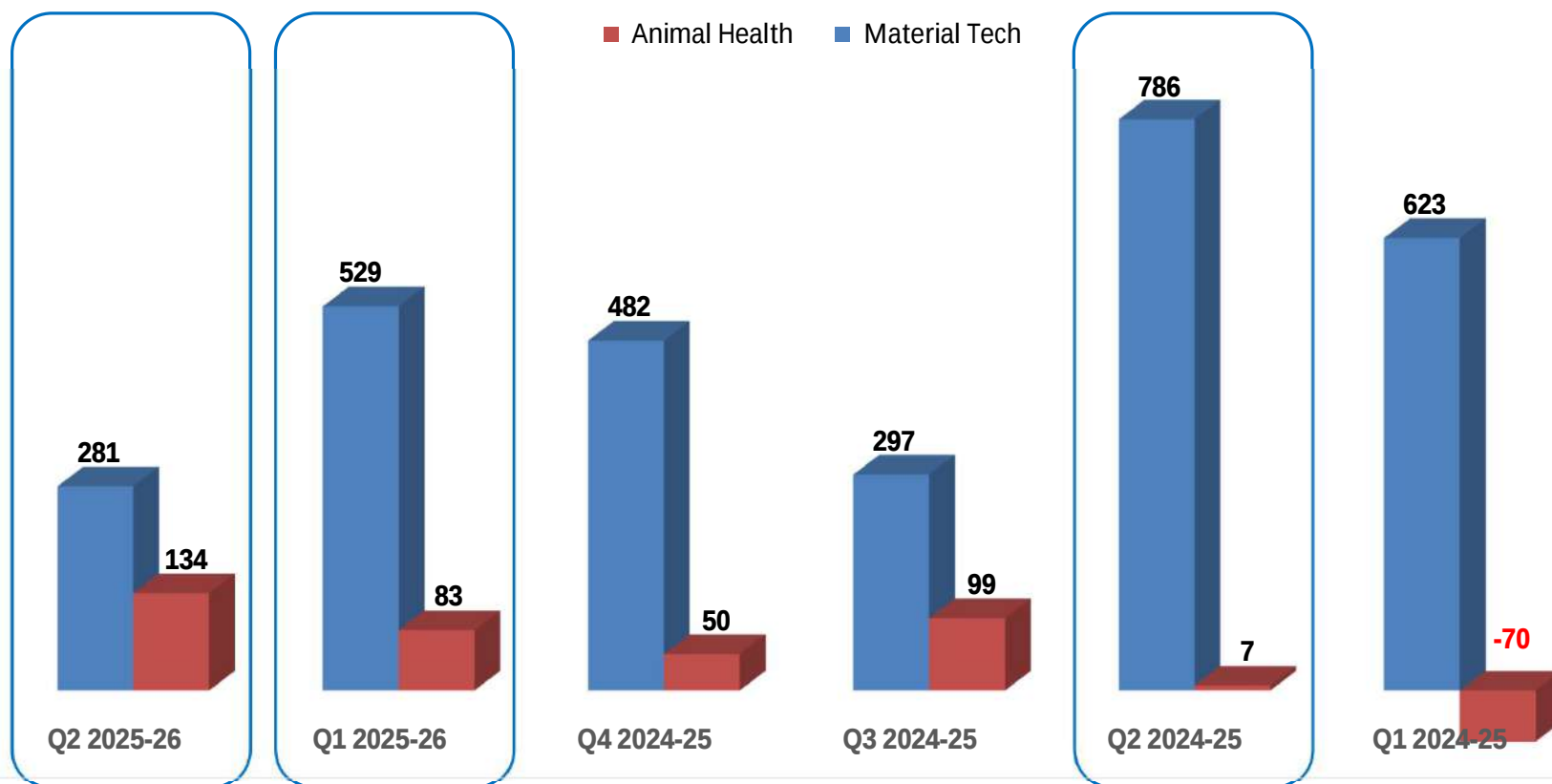

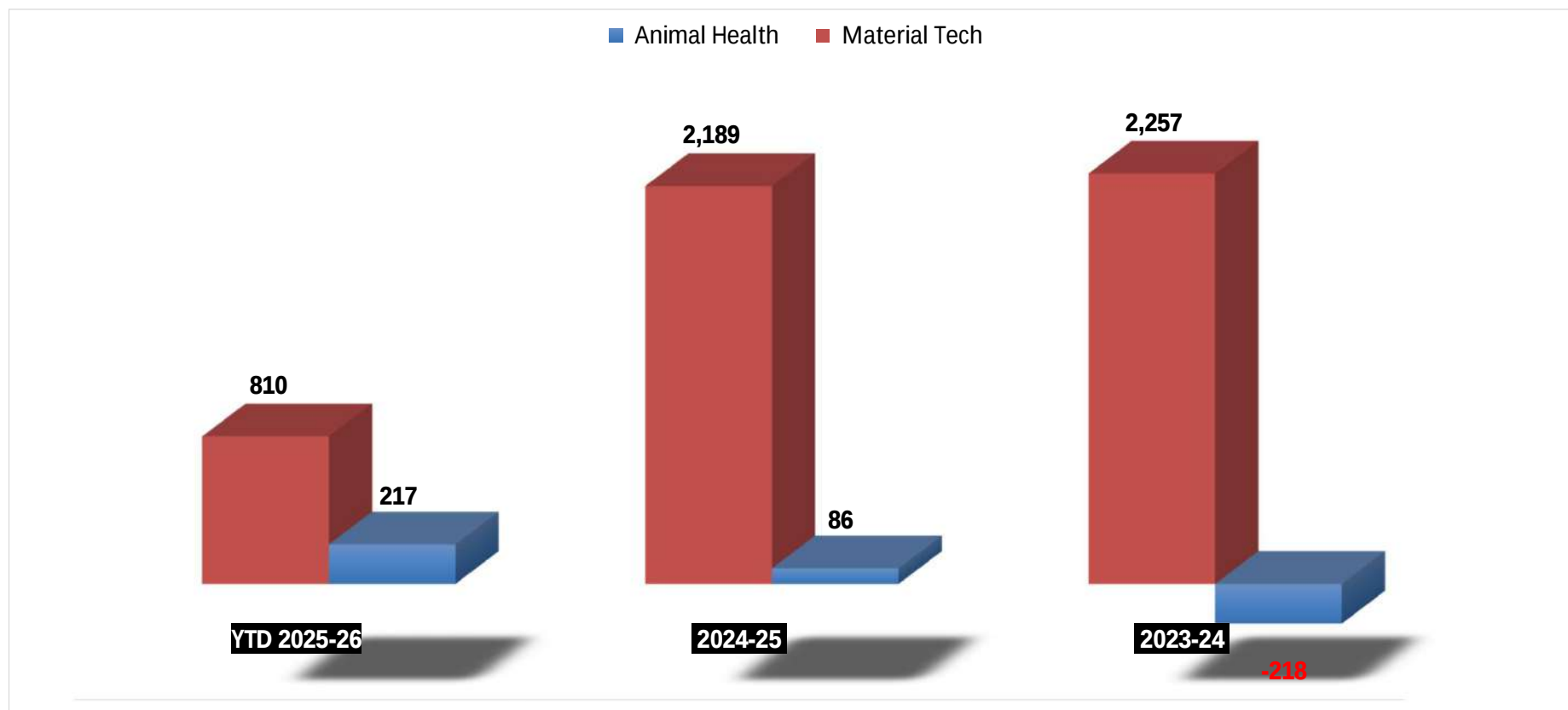
EBITDA – QoQ



Negative fair valuation from MF investments in Q2 FY26 and Q3 FY25 ; Received final insurance settlement against loss on fire in Q2 FY25

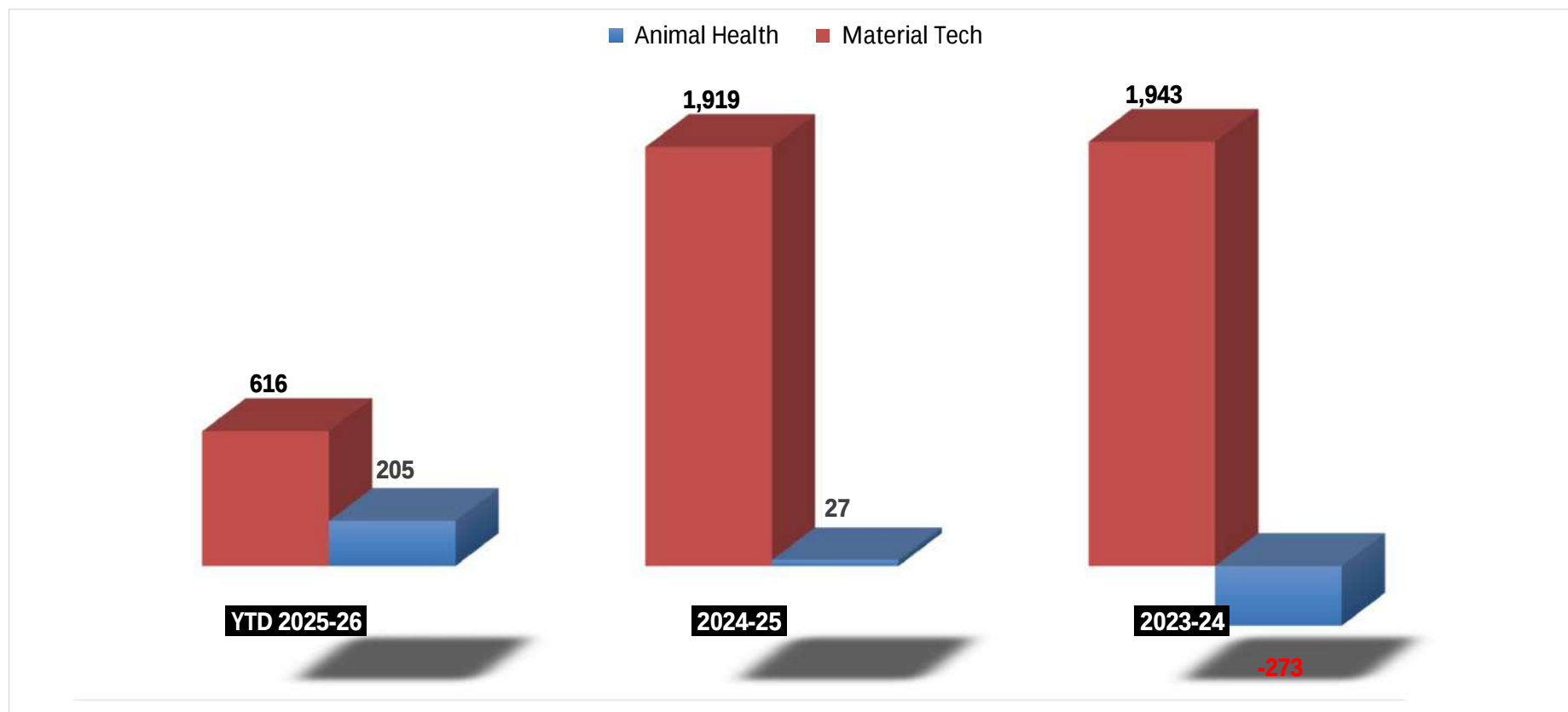
