
Product margin recovered slightly against Q1 FY26 and Q2 FY25 EBITDA and PBT dropped due to negative fair value of mutual fund investment


Revenue outlook remains positive

Share of Revenue by Segment





Revenues from Operations – QoQ



EBITDA – QoQ






Negative fair valuation from MF investments in Q2 FY26 and Q3 FY25; Received final insurance settlement against loss on fire in Q2 FY25

EBITDA - YoY


